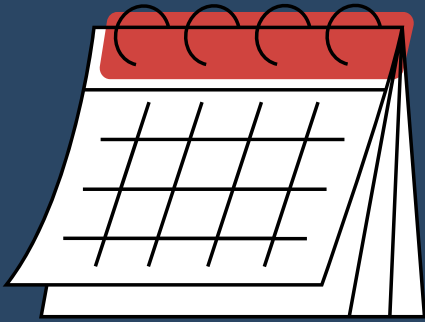

TIP OF THE WEEK

"Children and Salvation"



"Children of eight, ten or twelve years, are old enough to be addressed on the subject of personal religion. Do not teach your children with reference to some future period when they shall be old enough to repent and believe the truth. If properly instructed, very young children may have correct views of their state as sinners, and of the way of salvation through Christ." Testimonies, Vol. 1, p. 400.

"In the closing scenes of earth's history, many of these children and youth will astonish people by their witness to the truth, which will be borne in simplicity, yet with spirit and power. They have been taught the fear of the Lord, and their hearts have been softened by a careful and prayerful study of the Bible. In the near future, many children will be endued with the Spirit of God, and will do a work in proclaiming the truth to the world, that at that time cannot well be done by the older members of the church." "Parents who can be approached in no other way are frequently reached through their children. Sabbath school teachers can instruct the children in the truth, and they will, in turn take it into the home circle. But few teachers seem to understand the importance of this branch of the work. The modes of teaching which have been adopted with such success in the public schools could be employed with similar results in the Sabbath schools and can be the means of bringing children to Jesus and educating them in Bible truth. FUN FACTS FOR KIDS

The Great Wall of China



This month we are sharing facts about some of the 7 wonders of the world.

DID YOU KNOW?

- The Great Wall of China is located in China.
- The builders of the Great Wall included soldiers, forcibly-recruited peasants, convicts, and prisoners of war.
- It's said to be the longest man made structure in the world. The entire wall is over 21,000 kilometres long.
- There are sections made of stone gathered from the mountains. But in another spot, they might be made of earth and wood or even brick.
- To get all that brick and stone to stick, Chinese engineers used a mix of rice flour and limestone.
- It's believed that about a third of the wall has disappeared over the years. This is in part because of natural wear and tear, and partly due to foot traffic over the years. There are even stories about locals taking pieces from the wall to use for their own homes.
- Each May, the Great Wall Marathon is run on the Great Wall.



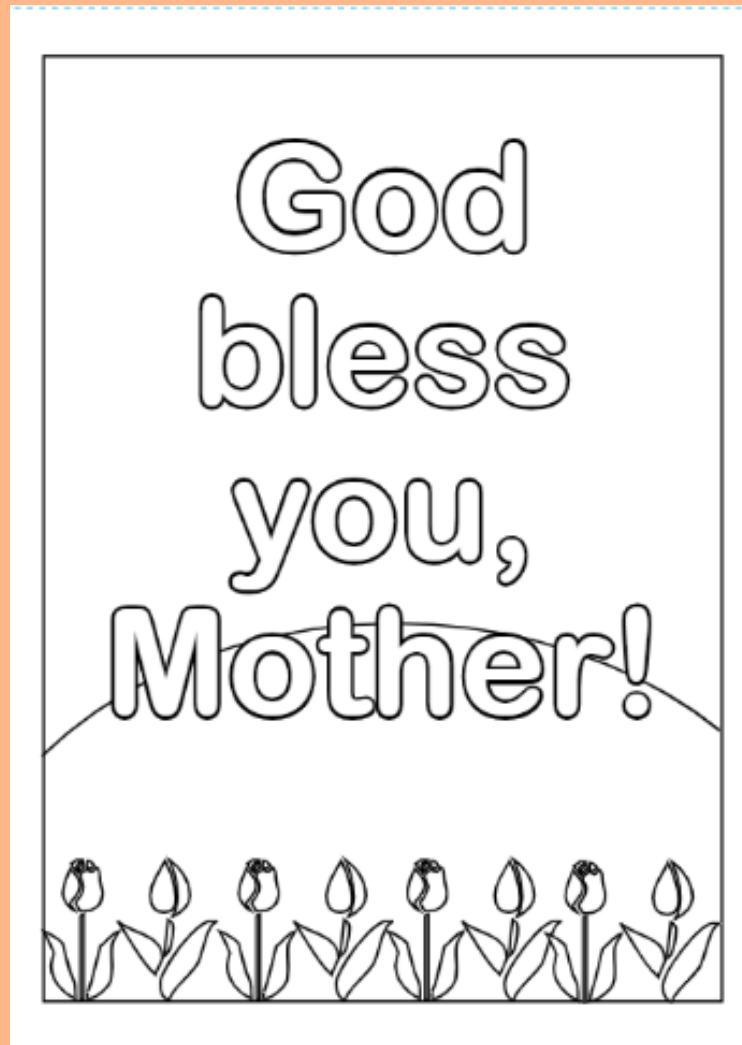
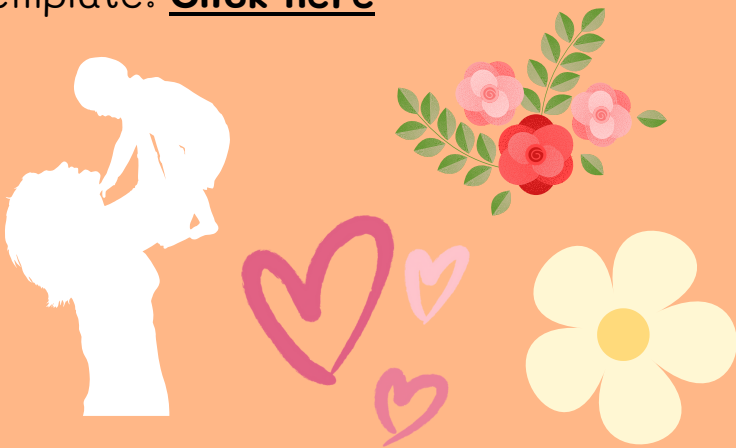
