



TIP OF THE WEEK

"JESUS VALUES CHILDREN"



"Those who love God should feel deeply interested in the children and youth. To them God can reveal His truth and salvation. Jesus calls the little ones that believe on Him, the lambs of His flock. FUN FACTS FOR KIDS

The Colosseum



This month we are sharing facts about some of the 7 wonders of the world.

DID YOU KNOW?

- The Colosseum is said to be built between 72 A.D and 80 A.D under the Emperor Vespasian, in the heart of Ancient Rome.
- It is made from stone and concrete and was built with the man power of tens of thousands of slaves.
- The Colosseum is the largest amphitheater in the world! Oval in shape, it measures 189m long, 156m wide and 50m high (about the height of a 12 storey buildings). This ancient sporting arena could easily fit a modern day football pitch inside!
- This building had 80 entrances and could seat approximately 50,000 spectators who would come to watch sporting events and games.
- Free for all! At the Colosseum's major events — often those organised and paid for by the emperors themselves — there was no entry fee. And free food was sometimes served, too. Bonus! Emperors would use this as a way to gain popularity and support from the public.
- Below the Colosseum were numerous rooms and underground passages. Here is where the animals and gladiators were kept.
- Although two-thirds of the colosseum has been destroyed over time — mostly the result of vandalism, earthquakes and fires — it is today a popular tourist site, attracting thousands of people every year!



CREATIVE CORNER

PAPER FLOWER CRAFT



Materials

- Purple, blue, yellow, green paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Green paint
- Wooden sticks (or straws)
- Black marker
- Blush (or pink marker)



Instructions

1. Draw nine large petals, sixteen medium petals and eleven small petals on blue paper and cut them out. Make a small cut at the bottom of the petals and glue them together according to their sizes (Large ones together, medium together etc.)



2. Draw 3 circles on the yellow paper and cut them out. Draw a face on each of them.

3. Glue the petals at the back of each face (each petal size has its own face).

4. Cut to size the wood sticks and paint them with green paint.



5. Draw six small leaves (same shape as the smallest petals) on green paper and cut them out. Make a small cut at the bottom of the leaves and glue them to the sticks (stem).



6. Glue the complete flowers on purple paper to make a canvas.
